(Note that aspects of the application are submitted using different methods: email and online. All portions of the application must be received on or before the deadline date.)

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the 2024 East Tennessee Performing Arts Association Championships on April 6th, 2024 at Jefferson County High School.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

1. CRITERIA

- **1.1.** Units must be registered members of ETPAA and eligible to compete at the 2024 ETPAA Championships for guard, winds, or percussion.
- 1.2. Students applying for the ETPAA Scholarships must be a high school senior and/or will be enrolled as a full-time student at a university, college, trade school, or career/technical school in the fall of 2024/Spring 2025. Current college students may apply if they are NOT in their final semester of study.

2. APPLICATION PROCESS

- **2.1. O N L I N E**: Complete the application found in the <u>FORMS & INFO</u> section of the ETPAA website. Be sure to complete the application when time is not an issue as there are several short answer questions. Read the instructions carefully throughout the application.
- 2.2. O N L I N E: Provide <u>accurate</u> email addresses for three (3) references on the online application. References should include your unit director plus two additional references NOT affiliated with your unit. Please do not list family members as references. You will receive a confirmation email when your references are notified.
- **2.3. E M A I L** : Submit your current school transcript via email to secretary@etpaa.org
 - High School transcript (official copy required) of the current semester or graduation date and SAT/ACT scores (copy accepted). Many schools provide these via email. If emailed, transcripts must be sent by a school official and not the student or director. **OR**
 - College transcript (if applicable).
- **2.4. E M A I L**: Submit two (2) photos of the applicant to secretary@etpaa.org. List your full name in the subject line of the email. Should the applicant be awarded a scholarship, these photos may be used on the ETPAA website and/or championship program.

Once your application is submitted, the individuals listed as references will receive the recommendation form via email within one week of your application submission. Please notify the individuals you submitted as references for this process; they may need to check their spam folder. In the event that your reference does not receive the form within 7 days of your submission, please email secretary@etpaa.org. References should be submitted before the application deadline to ensure they have ample time to complete their portion of the application.

3. DEADLINE

3.1. All applications must be complete, including reference letters, by March 13, 2024. Any application missing the required elements listed above will not be considered.
